Over this year a deep friendship builds between Mole and Ratty, who aided by the wise Badger, help the impulsive Mr. Toad get out of a series of sticky situations. This play is created to be enjoyed by both adults and children equally. The production features **Dan Ebbs** as Mole, **Kydra Ryan** as Rat, **Elizabeth Durand** as Badger and **Jason Rip** as Toad. AlvegoRoot digs back into London's theatrical past with this double bill of comedies from the early 20th Century entitled *Fools and Lovers*. The first play *Widows' Scarlet* (1939) is by one of London Ontario's first playwrights Hilda Mary Hooke. The play is inspired by the life of Doctor Troyer who lived near Long Point and fancied himself a witch hunter. The second play *Brothers in Arms* (1921) is by Merrill Denison, one of Canada's most successful early playwrights. The play is a satire about a businessman and his wife who, stuck in the bush, are attempting to get back to the city in time for an important business transaction. The production features **Casey Cornell**, **Dan Ebbs** and **Kydra Ryan**.

Both productions are directed by **Adam Corrigan Holowitz**, designed by **Sue Parke**, with musical direction by **Stephen Holowitz**. AlvegoRoot's 2019 season is supported by the London Arts Council, City of London and generous private donors.
