



## AlvegoRoot Theatre presents the world premiere of Slate Sisters

From March 18<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> AlvegoRoot Theatre will present the world premiere of AlvegoRoot Artistic Director **Adam Corrigan Holowitz's** play **Slate Sisters** at Somerville 630. The production directed by Corrigan Holowitz, features ensemble members **Kydra Ryan**, **Yunike Soedarmasto** and **Bronwyn Wilson** playing roles written specifically for them.

The play is set in an alternate version of the 1930s where men are absent. It is the height of the Golden Age of Radio; a world of glamorous celebrities, high flying tycoons and infamous gangsters. At the centre of this world are the legendary Slate Sisters who broadcast daily their radio comedy hour to millions of adoring fans. But when they head out on their first tour the limits of their world and the ties of sibling-hood are pushed beyond the breaking point.

"Writing this play began as an exploration of the golden age of radio. This led me to the question of what is a golden age. One definition is an imaginary past time. This is where the inspiration for Slate Sisters was born. I have written a lot about London's history but this definition got me interested in imagining a history that never really happened. Why do we dream, why do we imagine and what do we hope to find when we dream? These are the questions at the centre of this play." - **Adam Corrigan Holowitz, Playwright and Director**
