#### **Playwright's Notes**

Cy Warman (June 1855 – April 1914) was a literary force of his time. A contemporary of Mark Twain, Warman was known for his poetry depicting the American West. He was also a newspaper editor and journalist. He was editor of the Creede Chronicle in Creede Colorado. He made plenty of enemies in the line of work, including Bob Ford, the man who shot Jessie James.

This play could be called "Cy Warman in Love" because we look at a very specific moment in his life, and the part of his life that tied this American poet with London Ontario. Cy Warman found his way to London in 1891 because his beloved Marie Jones (September 1870 - January 1948). was here. During this time he wrote one of the most popular verses of the time, *Sweet Marie*. The poem would become a song by Raymond Moore which would in turn become the namesake for the chocolate bar. What you will see in this play is a fantasy based on this episode of his life.

Sweet Marie stands out from Warman's work, it is unashamedly romantic. As we wrote the play the question we could not help but ask ourselves was, who was Marie? We know at lot about Cy but not as much about Marie, except for what was written in the poem. We wondered does the poem reflect who Marie really was? What did Marie think of the poem? And can we ever truly put our love into words?

#### Sweet Marie by Cy Warman


I've a secret in my heart, Sweet Marie -A tale I would impart, Love, to thee.
